What started as a land grant for a farm in 1661, Meriden is now an active town with much to offer. Located in Central Connecticut, it has easy access to both the state's main highways (91 and 84). Its central location also makes it a short distance from both New Haven and Hartford, Connecticut's two major cities.

Meriden has a rich history. In the 1800s it became a manufacturing powerhouse and was given the name "The Silver City". This town has a great pride in the preservation of its history. The Solomon Goffe house, built in 1711, is the oldest house in town and today houses a museum for insight into the town's past. "Monument Boulevard" pays tribute to residents lost in various wars. The town remembers its rich past and looks toward a bright future. The town's Research Parkway, one of the town's newest industry areas, houses a growing group of biotech companies. The town also has a state approved Enterprise Zone which has drawn many corporate headquarters to move into the east side of town in recent years. Meriden is home to Mid State Medical Center which opened in 1998. This state of the art facility is the only in CT to offer only private rooms for patients. A new museum on West Main Street is being planned and a magnet school is under construction. Meriden has so much to offer.

Meriden's school system includes eight elementary schools, two middle schools, and two high schools. The town also has a therapeutic day school, an alternative education program for high school students, a program for young mothers to continue their education, and a technical school. The town School Readiness Program provides young children with the experience to prepare them best for kindergarten. The facilities and faculty employed by the Meriden school systems have received numerous awards and recognitions. For higher education, Meriden is located just a stone's throw away from many prestigious universities including Yale, Trinity, Wesleyan, Albertus Magnus, and St. Joseph.

Meriden is home to Hubbard Park, the largest municipal park in New England. This 1,800 acre park holds many wonderful features including a pool, playground, outdoor stage, Castle Craig tower, and many walking paths. Each year on the 4th of July fireworks burst over Castle Craig! Meriden also boasts a large shopping mall with something for everyone. The Augusta Curtis Cultural Center recently underwent a 2 million dollar town renovation and hosts many events for residents, from kick boxing class and casino trips to blood drives and puppet shows. The Max E. Muravnick Meriden Senior Citizens' Center offers many great classes and functions for the older generations too! Whatever you're looking for in a town, Meriden provides a smorgasbord of opportunities and facilities that make it a fantastic place to live!
